2017-2018 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Purpose:

To provide financial assistance to offset college expenses. Funds awarded may be used to defray the expense of college tuition and fees.

Goal:

To award Five (5) \$1,000 college scholarships to Five (5) students graduating in the 2017-2018 school year from a Public, Private or Home School in the Arlington, Mansfield and/or Kennedale, Texas service area.

Selection Process:

Open to high school seniors graduating in 2018 that are interested in any field of study. Selection for the Arlington Board of REALTORS® Community Service Foundation Scholarship will be based on the following criteria:

1. Student essay, maximum 300 words, entitled "How the Arlington Board of REALTORS® Community Service Foundation Scholarship will help me in preparing for my future." Scoring will be based on content, originality and overall impression.
2. Two Letters of Recommendation, from a teacher, counselor, school administrator, minister or any other person over 21 years of age, who is not related to the applicant. Please **DO NOT** mention the student's name in the body of these letters.
3. Academic Record- School Transcript(s)
4. School and Community Involvement
5. Financial Need

The Arlington Board of REALTORS® Community Service Foundation may require a personal interview with a finalist. If an interview is necessary, it will be conducted at the student's high school with either a parent/guardian or counselor present.

2. Completed Essay
3. Official High School Transcript
4. Letters of Recommendation
