

DOM (Days On Market) Calculations In [Matrix](#)

For Matrix, this is their standard method of DOM Calculation.

- DOM continues to calculate for any listing in an ACTIVE status - A, AO, AC, AK.
- DOM stops counting when a listings is CAN, TOM, WD, EXP.
- WD, that are reactivated will count DOM from original active date, but will now subtract any days during the "off market" time.
- Pending listings will calculate DOM from list date to "Contract Date".
- Pending listings that return to active, will subtract any days during the "off market" time.
- Sold listings will calculate DOM from list date to "Contract Date".

Status Definitions:

CS	Coming Soon Status (CS) – No DOM accumulation occurs while a listing is in the Coming Soon Status. Once a Coming Soon listing is changed to the Active Status, then the DOM starts at zero (0) on the first day of the Active Status. There is no consideration of the listing date for a CS listing change to Active. As a reminder, a listing may be in the Coming Soon status for up to 14 days. After 14 days, if no status change is made, the listing will automatically change to the Temporarily Off Market Status.
A	Active – Property is available for sale (showings). <i>Will expire on the original or amended expire date the agent has entered.</i>
AC	Active-Contingent – Property has an offer on it but there is a contingency (i.e. sale of a home, inspections) – still taking showings and considering Offers. <i>Will expire on the original or amended expire date the agent has entered. (short sales should be placed here)</i>
AO	Active-Option Contract – Property has an offer on it that has an option period – still taking showings and considering Offers. <i>Will expire on the original or amended expire date the agent has entered.</i>
AK	Active-Kick Out – Property has an offer contingent upon the sale of another property. <i>Will expire on the original or amended expire date the agent has entered. – still taking showings and considering other Offers.</i>
PND	Pending – Property has an offer (contract with contingencies, kick-outs or options please see above) – no more showings. Pending listings do expire, but they will stay pending until closed. Expired dates must be extended to include the Pending period. If NO SHOWINGS AND NO OFFERS are being further accepted, but agent is awaiting documents from lender/banks, they may place listing in this status.
EXP	Expired
SLD	Sold
LSD	Leased
WD \ WTH	Withdrawn – No longer available for showings. It is NOT available to be re-listed with another broker (under a "conditional release"). Listing still belongs to Original Broker. DOM will accumulate if reactivated. Cannot be re-listed
CAN	Cancelled – Unconditional release – free to be re-listed in MLS.
TOM	Temp Off Market –Owner has a reason they would not like to show the property for a period of time but they are still under a listing agreement. Temporarily off market used for various reasons (i.e. remodeling, owner illness, vacations, etc.). No DOM calculation occurs while a listing is in the TOM status. If a listing changes from the Coming Soon Status to the Temporarily Off Market status, then there is no DOM accumulation. The listing will <i>expire on the original or amended expire date the agent has entered.</i>
WS	Withdrawn Sub Listing – Under the sub-divided listing function, you can have a main listing with several sub listings....withdrawn sub listing would mean the sub listing is no longer available on its own.
<p>Note: CDOM (Cumulative Days on Market) – is a combination of any previous listing's DOM plus the current Listing's DOM. If a Listing is Cancelled, Expired, Sold; the CDOM computations will reset to "zero" after 30 days. The CDOM field reflects the property History Search and Results function. Re-list on day "31" to use the reset feature. CDOM will ALWAYS be visible to all members by reviewing the Property History.</p> <p>The DOM/CDOM ARE NOT publicly displayed fields and are not included in data feeds to other sites or on Customer Reports.</p> <p>Note: Purge Policy – Sold listings are kept in the system indefinitely. Expired and Cancelled listings are purged (eliminated) at 36 months. Purged listings History will remain in the system and available under Property History info.</p>	

MLS Status Definitions

CS Coming Soon No DOM accumulation occurs while a listing is in the Coming Soon Status. Once a Coming Soon listing is changed to the Active Status, then the DOM starts at zero (0) on the first day of the Active Status. There is no consideration of the listing date for a CS listing change to Active. As a reminder, a listing may be in the Coming Soon status for up to 30 days. After 30 days, if no status change is made, the listing will automatically change to the Temporarily Off Market Status.

ACT Active: **Property is available for sale and must be available for showings.** *Will expire on the original expiration date the agent entered.*

AC Active Contingent: **Seller has accepted an offer but has requested that property remain available for showings and Seller will entertain backup offers.** *Will expire on the original expiration date the agent entered.*

AOC Active Option Contract: **Seller has accepted an offer, but the Buyer is exercising the option period from the sales contract.** Still available for showings and backup offers. *Will expire on the original expiration date the agent entered.*

AKO Active Kick Out: **Property has an offer contingent upon the sale of another property by buyer. (Refer to TAR Form 1908)** Still available for showings and backup offers. *Will expire on the original expiration date the agent entered.*

PND Pending: **Property has an offer (Contract with no contingencies, Kick Outs or Options).** The seller requests no further

showings and does not want to entertain backup offers. *Pending listings do not expire and will stay pending until closed.*

WTH Withdrawn: **Based on the terms agreed to between the Seller and the Listing Broker in the “Termination of Listing Form” (TAR Form 1410) the property is no longer available for showings.** Due to the conditions of the “Termination Form” the property cannot be re-listed with another broker. *Will expire on the original expiration date the agent entered.*

CAN Cancelled: **Based on the terms agreed to between the Seller and the Listing Broker in the “Termination of Listing Form” (TAR Form 1410) the property is no longer available for showings.** There were NO conditions in the “Termination Form”. *The seller is free to re-list their property with another broker.*

Hold(H) [Old TOM]: **Owner has a reason they would not like to show the property for a period of time but they are still under a listing agreement.** Hold used to be called Temporarily off market and was used for various reasons (i.e. remodeling, owner illness, etc) THIS IS A TEMPORARY STATUS and should not be used in place of the Cancelled or Withdrawn status. *Will expire on the original expiration date the agent entered.*

EXP(X): **Listing has expired.** *The seller is free to re-list their property with any broker.*

Closed(C): **Listings has sold-closed.** *The new owner is free to list their property with any broker.*
