

Texas REALTORS® *Leadership Program* Application 2026

We are pleased to announce that the *Texas REALTORS® Leadership Program (TRLP)* is being offered in partnership with the REALTOR® associations in Region 3: Arlington (ARBOR) Greater Denton/Wise (GDWCAR), Granbury (GAR), Greater Fort Worth (GFWAR), Greater Lewisville (GLAR), Greater Metro West (GMWAR), Johnson County (JCAR), and Region 4: Greater Texoma (GTAR).

The program is designed to assist members to acquire leadership skills, strengthen their involvement on all levels of the REALTOR® organization, and provide them with a background in several topics of importance to REALTORS® seeking to take the next step in their career and volunteer leadership.

The program consists of eight modules that will be offered from Winter 2026 through Summer 2026, including an opening overnight retreat. Graduates of the TRLP are placed on the fast track for leadership opportunities at their local association and the Texas Association of REALTORS®.

Following the completion of an application, TRLP participants will be selected by an anonymous committee of participating board and association members. **The deadline to apply for the 2026 TRLP is 5:00 p.m., Monday, December 1, 2025.** Please submit applications to Melissa Hagood melissa@arlingtonrealtor.com.

The number of participants will be approximately 20. Since the number of appointments to the TRLP is limited, applicants who are not selected are encouraged to re-apply in subsequent years. A TRLP Selection Committee will select program members from a cross-section of the REALTOR® membership within the participating associations.

Participants are expected to attend **all** modules, including the overnight retreat. Those who fail to attend may be asked to withdraw, with no refund of tuition. Tuition for the eight-module program is \$500. This may be paid for entirely by the participant or in partnership with a broker or a sponsor. Times and dates for modules are listed below and will be held at local associations throughout Region 3 and 4, as well as the one overnight stay. Thank you for your inte18rest in applying!

Texas REALTORS® Leadership Program 2026 Schedule

Each TRLP module is unique and will feature speakers from several arenas of leadership. We will also meet with several of the top leaders within the REALTOR® association.
